CHEWING TOBACCO OR NEW DRUG?

We are increasingly hearing about children (and adults) who are chewing tobacco and subsequently displaying drug-use symptoms. In some cases the tobacco has been identified as Kuber tobacco, but it seems that the ingredients/additives might vary. We urge parents to be on the look-out for signs of use by their children and to then find out what exactly it is that's being chewed.

From reports it seems that the 'tobacco' is often packaged in what looks like teabags and has a peppermint or fruity smell so it's hard to detect. Parents report that their children become distracted, aggressive and 'spaced out'. Some employers report that on days when their staff are acting strangely (forgetful, argumentative or violent) it has subsequently turned out that they've been chewing (or brewing 'tea' from) Kuber or similar tobacco.

Reports indicate that the tobacco originates in India and is classified as a cigarette and not a drug, rendering police powerless to act against it. Some reports claim that it impairs memory, causes depression, contains a number of carcinogens, puts users in a 'trance' and is a threat to mental health.
